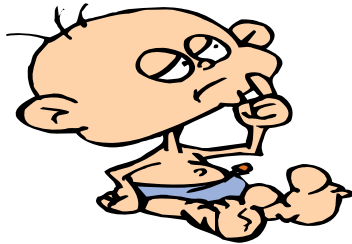

Rachel Levy M.S SLP CCC will lead Hebrew emersion classes for mother/caretaker and child that will include various theme centered activities such as arts and crafts, baking and circle time, encompassing Jewish themes and values.

Age appropriate Hebrew linguistic concepts are targeted through play and experiential learning enabling the child to interact with the language. A Hebrew music session will be led by Rachel as well who has a background in choir singing and rhythmic instrumentation. Get a head start on your child's Hebrew education!

Research has shown that Children, who are exposed to more than one language, even if they never fully learn that language, have a higher capacity for foreign language learning as teens or adults. Just playing foreign language cassettes in the home, and trying to speak whatever you know of a second language to your infants and young children will help their minds expand linguistically in a way that will give them an educational advantage later. Though in order to actually learn to communicate in a language, children must interact in that language, hence the importance of complete language emersion.
